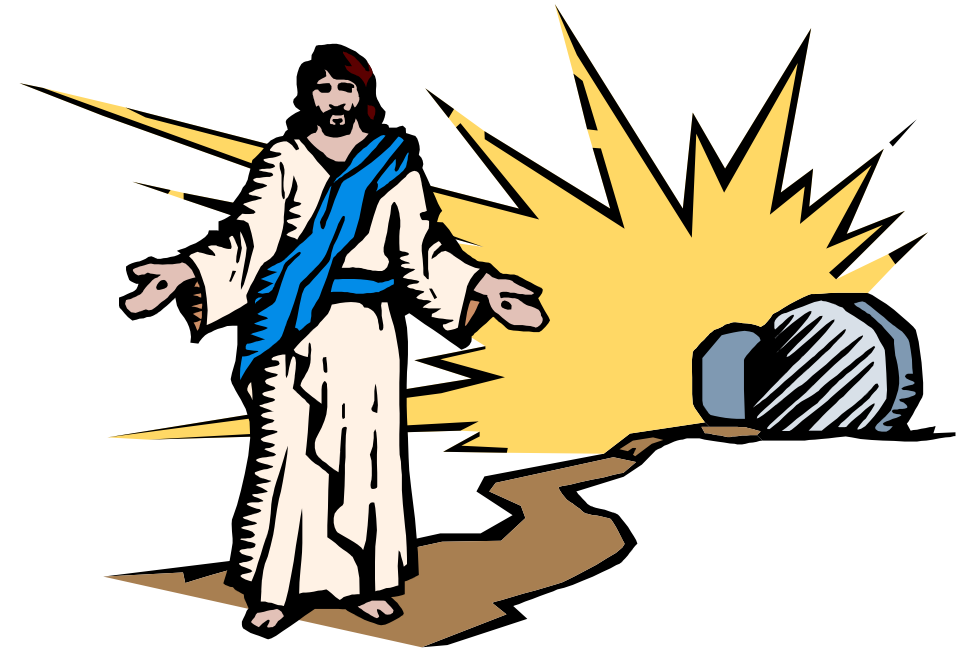

EASTER LITANY

Leader: Now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the first fruits of them that slept.
People: For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

Leader: But some men will say, How are the dead raised up? And with what body do they come?
People: All flesh is not the same flesh: but there is one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of beasts, another of fishes, another of birds.

Leader: There are also celestial bodies, and bodies terrestrial: but the glory of the celestial is One, and the glory of the terrestrial is another.
People: There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars: for one star differs from another star in glory.

Leader: So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption,
People: It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power.

Leader: It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.
People: So it is written. The first man Adam was a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

Leader: Behold. I show you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall be changed,
People: For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

Leader: Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
Together: Therefore, my beloved brethren, be you steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as you know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. (1st Corinthians 15)
